Explanatory note

The law regarding the prevention of money laundering and terrorism financing submits all professionals of the financial sector, including insurance companies, to various identification obligations such as identifying the Beneficial Owners.

- 1. Are considered as **Beneficial Owners** of a legal entity, according to the law, private individuals who, as a last resort:
 - possess directly or indirectly, a sufficient percentage of shares or rights to vote or a participation in the capital of that entity, or
 - exercise the control of that entity by other means.

A shareholder of 25% plus one share or an ownership interest of more than 25% in the customer held by a natural person shall be an indication of **direct ownership**.

A shareholder of 25% plus one share or an ownership interest of more than 25% in the customer held by a corporate entity, which is under the control of a natural person(s), or by multiple corporate entities, which are under the control of the same natural person(s), shall be an indication of **indirect ownership**.

The Beneficial Owners are always private individuals. So if one of the shareholders or decision makers is itself a legal entity, one must identify the private individuals who are the shareholders or decision makers of this shareholder/decision maker entity.

- 2. Are considered as **Politically Exposed People**, private individuals who are or have been entrusted with prominent public functions, so as their family members or people known for being associated to them, and includes the following:
 - Heads of State, heads of government, ministers and deputy or assistant ministers.
 - Members of parliament or of similar legislative bodies.
 - Members of supreme courts, of constitutional courts or of the high-level judicial bodies, the decisions of which are not subject to further appeal, except in exceptional circumstances.
 - Members of courts of auditors or of the boards of central banks.
 - Ambassadors, responsible business and high-ranking officers in the armed forces.
 - Members of the administrative, management or supervisory bodies of State-owned enterprises.
 - Members of the governing bodies of political parties.
 - Directors, deputy directors and members of the board or equivalent function of an international organization.
